Show Team

This division is the ideal starting point for those interested in all-star cheerleading. Show team is non-competitive, and coaches may be on the mat with the young performers during their routines.

Novice

The Novice division is an excellent option for both beginners and experienced athletes looking to improve their technique and performance skills in all-star cheer. Unlike other divisions that compete for placements, Novice Teams compete for rankings at competitions.

Prep

Prep teams are designed for athletes who have a background in cheerleading. The focus is on technique while also highlighting the showmanship of each athlete. Typically, athletes spend several years on the prep teams before advancing to the elite team.

Elite

Elite Teams require athletes to have extensive cheer training and excellent technical ability. This division is designed for individuals who are looking for an intense and highly competitive performance level.

Cheerabilites

Our Cheerabilities team, Legacy, welcomes all athletes ages 3 and up with disabilities or special needs. This team practices once a week and will perform at the same competitions as our other competitive teams. MAY 18TH

1

EVALUATIONS DAY 1

Day 1 evaluations will focus on tumbling and jumps. Athletes will be divided up amongst the floor and will demonstrate their skills. Evaluations will last an about an hour and a half.

MAY 19TH

2

EVALUATIONS DAY 2

Day 2 evaluations will focus on stunting. Coaches will divide all athletes up into different groups, and have the athletes showcase their stunting skills in different groups.

MAY 23RD

3

TEAM ANNOUNCEMENTS

Coaches will use the next few days to put together the teams, and they will be announced via email. Team placements are final once posted.

MAY 31ST

4

COMMITMENT DAY/ UNIFORM FITTINGS

After teams are announced, you will have ten days to decide if you will commit to the Impact Athletics 2024–2025 season. Commitment day will be held at the gym. All paperwork for the upcoming season will be filled out, contracts will be signed, and notarized on commitment day. We will also have uniform sizers available on hand, limited-edition pro-shop items available, and fun activities for the athletes.

FINANCIALS

TUITION

Our tuition fees are paid monthly per athlete, covering all team practices. The payment schedule this year will run on an 11-month term, commencing from 06/01/24 to 04/31/25. Payments must be made on the 1st or 15th of every month for the upcoming month and are automatically processed through Jack Rabbit, our class management software. There is no penalty for early payments. However, a late fee of \$15 will be charged on the 10th or 16th of each month for any overdue payments. Failure to keep up with payments may result in the athlete being dropped from the program. In such cases, full payment must be made before the athlete may return to practice or competition.

It's important to note that all tuition fees must be current before an athlete can participate in any team activities or collect any uniforms, clothing, or other items. Please be informed that we do **NOT** offer refunds for any reason.

FUNDRAISERS



ASSESMENTS

Assessments are the fees paid by the gym to external vendors. We offer various payment options to ease your payment of these assessments. These options include Pay in Full, 3-month, 6-month, or 10-month payment plans. Upon registration, a down payment of \$200 is required. The first assessment payment is due on the day of team commitment. Please note that assessments are **non-refundable** and **non-transferable**.

Assessment fees include Competition Fees, Choreography Fees, Camp Fees, Music Fees, Coaches Travel Fees, Team Bonding Activities, and End of The Year Banquet. Athletes are responsible for paying their own The Open/USASF Membership fee, where applicable.



POLICIES



UNIFORMS AND ATTIRE

To maintain a high standard of appearance and professionalism, we kindly ask that all Impact Athletics uniforms be kept in good condition. Should you lose or damage any uniform items, please report it to your coach immediately. Please note that the parent of the athlete will be responsible for the cost of replacement.

For practices, athletes are required to wear 90% black attire to the first practice of the week and IA gear to the second practice of the week. It is important to arrive at practice with shoes on and hair back. Athletes may have consequences when not dressed in appropriate attire for practice.

For competitions, athletes are not permitted to wear piercings and/or jewelry. Please keep this in mind when considering new piercings. Shoe color announcements will be made by commitment day on May 31st.

INJURIES

If an injury should occur, it is the responsibility of the parent to seek professional help. After seeing a physician, please provide us with an evaluation of the athlete's injury and status. An athlete with a serious injury will not be allowed to return to activity without a release from a medical professional. The athlete will still be required to attend practices even if they cannot participate.

DISCIPLINE

Athlete behavior outside of the gym is a representation of Impact Athletics and their team; on social media, school, church, etc. All athletes are held to a higher standard. We expect our cheerleaders to be LEADERS, and if we have to question this at any point, the athlete is subject to punishment that could result in removal from the program. Poor athlete behavior/attitude at practice, along with competitions, will result in punishment and possibly removal from the program.

- 1st violation- Meeting with the athlete to define the problem
- 2nd violation-Meeting with the athlete and parent
- 3rd violation- Athlete may be removed from the team or entire program

SKILL BUILDING

Once each team receives their choreography, the tumbling skills worked during practice will only be those needed for the routine. There is not enough time to fix all aspects of the routines and also focus on advancing in skill levels. If your athlete wants to continue to learn new skills, you may contact the front office to enroll in classes or private lessons.

All-star cheerleading is a unique sport where each team member has a crucial role to play in the routine. Unlike other sports, there are no benchwarmers or substitutes, making attendance and punctuality critical. If your child is involved in other activities that could interfere with team practice, our recreational teams may be a better option.

Our coaches strive to accommodate the needs of both the individual and the team by adjusting lesson plans with sufficient notice. However, we do have attendance policies in place to ensure that all team members are committed to their role.

For every absence, whether excused or not, the athlete must do 50 toe-touches as makeup. From August-April, athletes are allowed a maximum of two unexcused absences. After this, the family's Jack Rabbit account will be charged \$35 for every absence. During competition week, there is a zero-tolerance policy for any absences, whether excused or unexcused. Any missed practice during this week will result in a charge of \$75 to the family's Jack Rabbit account. Excessive absences may result in the athlete's removal from the team.


